Parish Council

The Parish Council was a fairly quiet affair after the open forum. We introduced Simon Crossley to the team which brings us up to our full compliment of 10.

The cheques were signed and all payments approved.

After paying the Defib payment the clerk set up a direct debit so as not to miss the payment.

With no planning matters at the moment we moved on to Parish Initiatives:- The planters in the market place had been installed and filled with compost and topsoil before Frank Stark purchased some flowers. They look grand along with the hanging baskets and are watered on a regular basis. The Gym Equipment grant has been secured with PC match funding £1300 towards it and the play ground swing. The new Lantern has made its way to Steve who is going to rewire it for us before we get an electrician to fit. Binbrook Calendar will be on show...Well the update is that they were on show in the church and numerous members of the village voted for there favourites these were sorted and the top 12 have now become the 2025 calendar which will be on sale at the Scarecrow event, due to rising costs they will be £7:50 each and we have ordered 100 so first come first served.

Wiping through communication with the village, there is more in the Flyer than made it into the minutes thanks to the contributors and their articles.

Finally we had Matter for Discussion. The missing stile on the Ludford Road has be passed to the solicitor of the owner of the field for a replacement and that's all we can do. Parking on the Louth Road was checked out and a solution was tried, which it seems didn't work. The PC has no power in these sorts of problems but we will try to sort them out, sometimes to no avail. The drain at Southfields will be looked at again by Cllr Simon Crossley with a big stick. Finally the CCTV notice on the play equipment has been removed a new one will be bought.

Due to the damage on the Jubilee Tree over at the skate Park the swing second swing is on hold.....We are no in the mind to reward bad behaviour. It will be discussed next month.
